Phenomenological Educational Science - continental perspectives on history, epistemology and methodology

The presentation outlines the history, epistemological and methodological foundations and important findings of phenomenological educational science in continental Europe. Since more than hundred years a specific approach to pedagogical phenomena and practices has been developed. For example, a phenomenological theory of learning, a phenomenological theory of Bildung, a phenomenological theory of the pedagogical relationship and a phenomenological theory of pedagogical practices were elaborated. I argue that phenomenological educational science should by no means be categorised as a philosophy of education or as applied phenomenology. Rather, it can be regarded as an independent discipline in the human science tradition with its own research programme, which distinguishes itself from other scientific approaches, paradigms and disciplines in education.

Biography:

Malte Brinkmann has the chair of General Educational Science at the Humboldt Universität zu Berlin. His research focuses on theories of learning, Bildung and education, classroom research and phenomenological educational science. He is the host of an international symposium on phenomenological educational science and the editor of a series on phenomenological educational science published by Springer.
