Teaching children to become tolerant, empathetic and inclusive through talking and thinking together!

The DIALLS (DIalogue and Argumentation for cultural Literacy Learning in Schools) project aimed at developing young people's sense of 'being European' and enhancing their understanding of their own cultural identities and heritages through intercultural dialogue and mutual understanding. The project works with 300 classes across Europe and in Israel, using wordless picture books and films as the stimulus for discussions about themes around social responsibility and living together. Fiona Maine led the three-year EC Horizon 2020 project and will outline the project journey and outcomes, explore the underpinning framework for the concept of cultural literacy as a dialogic social practice, and talk about how this can be promoted in classrooms.
